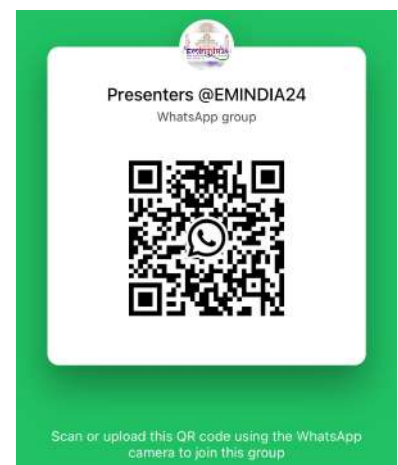

Dr Singh is currently working as a Urologist in Canada. After completing his medical graduation (MBBS) in 1991 and Master of Surgery (MS) in 1995 from Institute of Medical Sciences, Banaras Hindu University (BHU), Varanasi, India; Dr. Singh moved to Mumbai and completed his Urology residency training (Diplomate of National Board) from P.D.Hinduja Hospital, Mumbai, India and later worked in Christian Medical College (CMC), Vellore, India as senior registrar. In early 2001, he went to Canada and successfully completed ASTS (American Society of Transplant Surgeons) accredited renal transplant fellowship from Dalhousie University, Halifax, Canada. In 2004, he completed his sub-specialisation in male infertility from University of Toronto, Canada. Apart from General Urology, Dr Singh has a special interest in male infertility including vasectomy reversal surgery and renal transplantation.
